If you already know which minor stream you want to choose (organisation / media), please tell about your motivation and learning aim for the stream, you have chosen.

# Step 3: Creative assignment

## **How to make the video?**

- ✓ The video must be minimum 3,5 and maximum 4 minutes long and in international signs
- ✓ Feel free to be creative with the structure, content and illustrations!
- ✓ Stream the video to YouTube or Vimeo and remember to allow us to watch the video with the given link

## Step 4: An interview

When you have sent your application AND creative assignment, we will make an interview appointment with you.

The interview will be 30 minutes long and its nonformal, you do not need to be prepared in before hand.

We will interview You through Whereby / Facetime / Skype after agreement
